



# Safety rules

## 1. Admission:

The Park is only accessible to people whose physical and mental abilities allow them to practise independently in accordance with safety requirements.

Staff must be able to maintain visual and verbal contact with each participant at all times.

**By paying the entrance fee, you agree to all the rules.**

**One entrance to the park entitles you to 3 consecutive hours of activity\*.**

Participants must have accident insurance, wear closed-toe shoes, tie back long hair, and refrain from wearing clothing that could cause strangulation.

**The maximum weight limit is 115 kg.**

Individuals who are inadequately equipped and/or under the influence of alcohol or narcotics will not be permitted to enter the park.

## 2. Equipment and access to courses:

Equipment is provided by **Parc Aventure Chaumont** (1 pair of gloves, 1 harness, 2 'click-it' lanyards and 1 pulley).

**The safety briefing** is mandatory.

The equipment is **non-transferable** and must be used in accordance with our instructions. The return of the equipment is final.

Children aged 4 to 7 years old can use the continuous lifeline courses. Parents must be present to supervise their children either from the ground or on the courses.

Self-belay courses are accessible to children aged 7 and over who are at least 125 cm tall. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied or supervised by an adult (on the ground). From the age of 14, children can use all courses (except black) on their own.

It is compulsory to start with a yellow or green course, and you agree to only use the courses you are authorised to use.

**On the courses**, you must use the games one at a time, with a maximum of two people on the platforms.

**On the zip lines**, you must check that there is no one else on the cable and adjust your speed (braking) to ensure a slow landing.

## 3. General terms and conditions of sale

Management reserves the right to suspend activities in the event of bad weather (wind or risk of thunderstorms).

In the event of permanent closure, if you have participated in less than one hour of activities, **Parc Aventure Chaumont** will offer you **one voucher for one free entry**.

When making a reservation, if **you wish to cancel**, you must do so at least 24 hours before your arrival date, otherwise you will not be refunded.

*We reserve the right to exclude anyone who does not comply with safety instructions and accept no responsibility in the event of an accident, loss and/or theft of valuables. By participating in the activity, you accept that it involves certain risks and waive any claim or legal action for damages in the event of an accident.*

**\*After 3 hours and 15 minutes of activity, you will be charged CHF 10 for each additional hour.**
